September - December, 2015

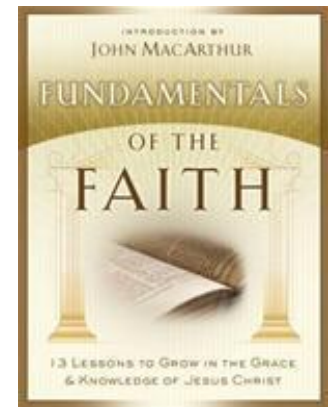
A Sunday School class on **Fundamentals of The Faith (FoF)** is starting on Sunday September 6th, 2015. The class uses the **Fundamentals of The Faith Workbook** developed at **Grace Community Church** in Sun Valley, CA. **Heinz Lycklama** will be teaching the class in the church sanctuary. New and mature believers, as well as those investigating the truth of Christianity, are encouraged to attend. There will be something for each participant in this class.

The Workbook provides thirteen lessons that blend basic biblical truths with personal obedience and service. These classes enable believers to grow in their understanding of biblical truths. With topics ranging from the character of God to church participation, it's an ideal study for discipling new believers or returning to the basics of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. You can use these thirteen lessons to firmly establish and sincerely practice your faith.
