
1. The Mission Command



 - Mass and energy is all there is
 - No supernatural being
- ◆ Biblical
 - God exists
 - The Bible is true







Components of a Worldview

- ◆ Origins (Where did I come from?)
- ◆ Ontology (Who am I?)
- ◆ Purpose (Why am I here?)
- ◆ Epistemology (How do I know?)
- ◆ Ethics and Morals (What am I to do?)
 - Ethics: what I ought to do
 - Morals: what I actually do
 - Aesthetics (What is good or beautiful?)
- ◆ Eschatology (Where am I going?)






4. Challenges For Youth




6. Critical Thinking Skills

"It is now generally conceded that the art of thinking critically is a major missing link in education today, and that effective communication and problem solving skills,

as well as mastery of content, requires critical thinking."

Richard Paul, Director, Center of Critical Thinking

- Three critical thinking questions
 - How do you know it is true?
 - Has it ever been observed?
 - Are you making any assumptions?






Applying Critical Thinking

- Beware of fuzzy words
 - We believe, we think, could have, might have, must have
 - No observable evidence





- Beware of red flag words
 - All, everybody, no real scientist, intolerant
 - Sweeping generalities or personal opinions





Some Examples

- "Paleontologists think that Archaeopteryx and today's birds descended from some kind of reptile, possibly from a dinosaur."
- "Evo-devo proposes that genes involved in cobbling together flesh and bones during early growth were repurposed to develop new structures throughout evolution's history, by combining their functions in new ways."



Red-Flag Statements

- ◆ There are no absolutes
- People should decide for themselves what is right and wrong



- ♦ All real scientists believe in evolution
- ♦ No one has the whole truth
- ♦ That's true for you, but not for me
- ♦ That's just your opinion











3 Stages of Evolution

- 1. Cosmic (Stellar) Evolution
 - Evolution of the universe, including galactic clusters, galaxies, stars, solar systems, planets
- 2. **Biochemical** (Chemical) Evolution
 - Evolution of first life from nonlife
 - Abiogenesis
- 3. Biological (Organic) Evolution
 - Evolution from common ancestor
 - Molecule to man (Macro-Evolution)










The Meaning of Evolution

- **Artificial Selection**
 - Plant and animal breeding

Only 1, 2 and 3 have been observed

- 2. Change
 - Evolution of a coastline (random)
 - Evolution of a car (designed)
- 3. Micro-Evolution [Adaptation]
 - Small variation within prescribed limits of complexity
 - e.g., finch beaks by mutation & natural selection
- 4. Macro-Evolution ← 4 never observed!

- Particles -> people
- 5 is impossible! 5. Molecular Evolution ←
 - Origin of life assumes a mutating replicator










Laws of Nature





The Evolutionists' Response?


- "Even if all the data point to an intelligent designer, such a hypothesis is excluded from science because it is not naturalistic."



7a. Reliable Transmission of the Bible

- Reliability depends on:
 - Number of copies of manuscripts
 - Time gap, original to earliest copy
- ◆ Dead Sea scrolls found 1947
 - Earlier (by 1000+ yrs) copies of OT manuscripts
 - Dated to 100-200 BC
- ♦ Earliest <u>NT</u> manuscript
 - Fragment of John's gospel
 - Dated to 125 AD
 - Referenced by church fathers




99.99% of originals reclaimed

7b. Historical Accuracy of the Bible

- Gospel of Luke & Acts
 - Written by Dr. Luke
 - Eyewitness and Apostles reports
 - 32 countries, 54 cities, 9 islands
 - Exact titles of historical figures
 - Accurate history & geography
- Pool of Bethesda discovered
- ♦ Ebla tablets found in 1974
 - Confirm biblical places
 - Confirm writing ability of Moses
- Confirmed by archaeology
 - Archaeologists use Bible as guide





7c. Fulfilled Prophecy of the Bible

- ♦ 27% of Bible prophetic (when written)
 - 500+ of 1000+ prophecies fulfilled
- ♦ 300 prophecies about Messiah
 - 109 fulfilled in His 1st Coming
 - Birthplace, sold for 30 pieces
- Prophecies about people, places
 - Fall of Babylon, Jer. 50-51
 - Destruction of Tyre, Ezek. 26
 - Cyrus as ruler, Is. 44:28
- Prophecies about Jews
 - Dispersion and re-gathering
- ♦ Is. 61:1-2, Luke 4:18-19a
 - Dead Sea Scrolls

7d. Biblical Truth in Science?

- ♦ We trust the Bible for <u>spiritual</u> truth
- Archaeology, <u>history</u>, <u>geography</u>, and <u>prophecy</u> confirm the truth of the Bible




- ♦ Do we trust the Bible for truth in science?
 - Astronomy, geophysics, geology, hydrology, meteorology, oceanography, physics, biology
- There are many biblical references to nature and natural processes
 - Authors use everyday language
 - Amazingly accurate statements
 - Anticipatory scientific insights in the Bible



Scientific Accuracy of the Bible

- Five categories: matter, space, time, force, action
- ♦ Biblical references to science:
 - Number of stars -10**22
 - Earth as a sphere
 - Earth suspended in space
 - Earth spinning on its axis
 - Hydrologic cycle
 - Life is in the blood
 - Circumcision on day 8
- Science disciplines established by Bible-believing scientists




- What is Apologetics?
 - Defense of the Christian Faith
- 1 Pet. 3:15, " ... always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; ..."
- Jude 3, "... I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints."
- 2 Cor. 10:4-5, "For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ"

Why Apologetics?


- Why?
 - Know what you believe
 - Know why you believe
 - Defend what you believe − 1 Pet. 3:15
- ♦ How?
 - Rightly divide the word of truth II Tim. 2:15
 - Be a Berean, search the Scriptures daily Acts
 17:11
 - Look for evidence of the Truth
 - Answer the questions of believers & skeptics alike
 - Acts 17:17, "Therefore he [Paul] reasoned in the synagogue with the Jews and with the Gentile worshippers, ...





Purposes of Apologetics

- ◆ To obey God's Word
- ◆ To glorify God
- To strengthen and encourage believers



- ◆ To evangelize and have answers to challenges from non-believers
- ♦ To bring down strongholds
- ◆ To equip the next generation (+parents)
 to maintain a biblical worldview



Why Christian Apologetics?

- 1 Pet. 3:15, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and <u>always be ready to give a defense</u> to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;"
- Matt. 22:37, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."
- 1 Th. 5:21-22, "Test all things; hold fast what is good. Abstain from every form of evil."
- 2 Cor. 10:5, "casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,"
- Jude 3, "to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints."




What is Truth?


- ♦ Truth is that which corresponds to reality
 - Thought applies to reality
 - Knowledge is possible
 - Logic is a necessary presupposition of all thought
 - It is undeniable that logic applies to reality
 - Self-evident principles cannot be denied
- Truth is <u>absolute</u>, <u>correspondent</u>, <u>knowable</u>, <u>logical</u>
- ♦ The Bible claims to be the Word of God & true
- Does the Bible correspond to reality?
 - Is the Bible true?



Is The Bible True?

- ◆ Some people say the Bible is full of errors or contradictions
- For most this is just an excuse for not believing
- Few who claim these errors have read the Bible and analyzed any of these alleged errors
- Many books written to address alleged errors







Alleged Errors in the Bible

- a. Law of non-contradiction
 - > Fails truth test
 - e.g. Gen, 1 and Gen. 2
- b. Mistranslations
 - Not true to original language
 - Go back to the original
- c. So-called scientific errors
 - > Authors used language of the day
 - Rising and setting of the sun



a. Law of Non-Contradiction

- ♦ Bible was written
 - By 40 authors from many walks of life
 - Over a period of 1500 years
- ♦ Bible has ONE author God
 - God is perfect, holy, true
- ◆ There are no contradictions in His Word, no matter what it seems at first
- Many supposed contradictions



Example of Alleged Non-Contradiction

- Many supposed contradictions result by placing two passages in false opposition to each other, e.g.
 - Eccl. 7:29, "God made man upright." –
 Talking about Adam and Eve, who God originally created upright
 - Ps. 51:5, "Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity." Here King David is speaking of his personal situation, as a fallen descendant of Adam
- ♦ There is no contradiction here



b. Mistranslation

- ◆ Translation of the books of the Bible can be a real challenge
- We have many translations
 - KJV, NKJV, AS, NAS, NIV, etc.
- Most translation problems have simple explanations
- You should always look at the original Hebrew and Greek words used



Example of Mistranslation

- ◆ Lev. 11:13,19, "And these you shall regard as an abomination among the birds; they shall not be eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle, the vulture, the buzzard, ... and the bat." (NKJV)
 - Bats are not birds (a questionable word)
- ♦ The KJV uses the word "fowls" instead of the word "birds"
- ◆ The KJV used the word "fowls" in **Lev. 11:20** to describe "insects"



Explanation of Mistranslation

- ◆ The Hebrew word used is "owph," which can mean anything that "has a wing," i.e. a winged creature
- ◆ The Hebrew word "owph" includes birds, flying insects, and bats
- Going back to the Hebrew word explains the supposed translation problem









c. Alleged Scientific Errors

- ♦ Authors used the language of their day
 - The sun rising in the morning
 - The sun setting in the evening
 - The sun does not "rise" and "set"
 - The earth actually rotates
 - Our talk of the sun rising and setting is not "scientifically correct"
 - Spoken from perspective of the observer





Evolutionary Theory in a Nutshell

How Evoluton Works:

- 1. Random chance mutations cause changes, or variation, in a population of organisms.
- 2. These different organisms then compete to survive and reproduce.
- Those which are best able to survive and reproduce do so, and tend to leave the most offspring. This is called "natural selection."
- 4. Over time, if some organisms survive and reproduce more than others, a species will "evolve."

Evolution claims:

- All organisms are related through "common ancestry."
- All organisms arose through the process of mutation and natural selection.
- All organisms arose and persist because of the random chance processes of nature.

The story of evolution:


Origin of the Universe → Origin of Earth → Pre-Biotic Synthesis ("primordial soup")

Bacteria ← First Cells ← DNA / Protein World ← RNA World

▶Primitive Animals → Fish → Amphibians → Reptiles* → Mammals

Humans ← Hominids ← Early Apes ← Monkeys ← Lower Primates

"Evolutionary theory says some reptiles also turned into birds.
